#### 089/14/01: APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Councillor A Gibbs Barton, Councillor G Thompson and Councillor A Turnbull.

Councillor B W Elliott declared an interest in the Planning Application: 13/03924/FUL.

## 091/14/03: THE PORT OF BLYTH

(The report is attached to the signed copy of the minutes)

The Chair, Councillor G T Knox welcomed Martin Lawlor to Blyth Town Council and invited him to provide his presentation.

Following the presentation, the Chair thanked Mr Lawlor for his excellent presentation on behalf of the Council. Questions were then posed regarding his presentation.

Councillor G T Knox enquired as to whether there is still scope for the Port of Blyth to transfer to the north side of the river as previously discussed. Mr Lawlor replied that due to the aforementioned growth in the presentation that this site would no longer be applicable for development due to its size.

Councillor G T Knox commented that in recent consultations it has been discussed that Blyth's Town Centre was or could be encouraged to migrate towards the developments on the Quayside area. Mr Lawlor commented that he has been encouraging development within the Quayside area and would support positive the redevelopment of the Quayside for the benefit of Blyth.

Councillor J R Potts asked Mr Lawlor as to whether there was scope for the reintroduction of passenger services between Blyth and North Blyth to service demand and future proposed developments such as the Biomass Power Station. Mr Lawlor commented that it would be unlikely that the Port would have any issues with such a reintroduction however this was dependant on demand and funding.

Councillor J R Potts also enquired as to whether there could be scope for a walk through the Port of Blyth in order to link the strategic assets within the Town. Martin Lawlor commented that this could not happen due to the Port's operational nature and the security requirements imposed on the Port.

The Town Clerk (Democratic Services) enquired as to how the Commissioners at the Port were chosen. Mr Lawlor replied that this process was dealt with by central government.

Discussion was then held regarding the potential to host a large scale Tall Ships event on the Quayside.

Councillor J R Potts sought clarification regarding the fuel storage site to be situated on the river behind Morpeth Road School. Mr Lawlor commented that this was a safe development and also noted that almost all transportation would be conducted via sea with less than 1% expected via road.

Councillor G T Knox commented that he wished to continue engagement with the port and suggested the organisation of regular meetings. This was **AGREED** to proceed with suggestion that meeting be held quarterly.

The Town Clerk (Democratic Services) commented that potentially the Port of Blyth's formal report could be repeated for the Planning & Development Committee.
