Question raised during the session

Bolam Park Allotment Site

A question was raised about the possibility of getting the lanes scraped and rolled instead of renewing them like the rest of the allotments.

The General Services Officer advised that this would be a cheaper option than using eco proactive. It would include all 9 lanes on the site.

There is also a problem with the car park as it is being used as a turning point by taxis and other vehicles. The GSO said it may be beneficial to look at a dropped bollard. He will explore costs and bring them back to the next Environment Committee.

It was clarified that BTC have a statutory responsibility for the lanes, water and fencing on the allotments.
